PRIOR KNOWLEDGE: VOCABULARY TO KNOW

<u>Scale</u>: relationship between portion of Earth being studied and earth as a whole.


<u>Place</u>: a specific point on earth, distinguish by a particular characteristic. Every place occupies a unique location or position on earth.

<u>Location</u>: a coordinate (like in math) to identify where a specific place is on earth. Includes latitude and longitude.

Region: is an area of earth defined by 1 or more distinctive characteristics.

<u>Map</u>: model of the earth's surface or part of it. It's a reference tool & a communications tool. A cartographer is a mapmaker.

MINI LESSON: HOW ARE THESE DIFFERENT?

GEOGRAPHY

- IDENTIFY THE LOCATION OF IMPORTANT PLACES.
- EXPLAIN WHY 1 HUMAN ACTIVITY IS FOUND NEAR ANOTHER.

HISTORY

- IDENTIFY DATES OF IMPORTANT EVENTS.

- ASK WHEN AND WHY.
- RECOGNIZE THAT AN ACTION AT 1 POINT IN TIME CAN RESULT FROM PAST ACTIONS & CAN IN TURN AFFECT FUTURE ONES.

PLACE: A UNIQUE LOCATION

Humans possess a strong sense of place – that is, a feeling for the features that contribute to the distinctiveness of a particular spot on earth. How do we describe a place? 3 ways...

All places on earth have a toponym – a name given to a place. Have you considered how Istanbul got its name?

Site – the physical character of a place. Includes climate, water sources, vegetation, elevation.

The last way we describe a place is through situation – relative location and absolute location.
