Cholera, a disease caused by impure water, was a chronic problem. An Ottoman cartoon from 1911 satirizes life during a cholera outbreak. In the first part, a woman has stomach cramps while walking down a street. Since stomach cramps are a symptom of cholera, officials rush to disinfect her.
