- 1. How long and wide is the island of Cyprus? *The island is 160 miles long and 60 miles wide at its widest point.*
- 2. What body of water surrounds the island? *The Mediterranean Sea surrounds the island.*
- 3. Why has Cyprus been described as a "crossroads of history"? Cyprus has been a place where sea travelers from Europe, Africa, and Asia could rest and find fresh water and supplies. It was also a supplier of copper. It controlled the eastern end of the Mediterranean Sea.
- 4. List three cultures that have conquered or influenced Cyprus in its history.
