Assignment Option 1: Designing a Booklet

Task: Create a booklet. Half will be a survival guide for fish, half a survival guide for people

Planning:

- 1. Plan your survival guide for fish:
- title page (with your name on it as the author)
- overview and statement of purpose (e.g.: to help fish who want to explore the world)
- list of what one needs to survive (things to bring, attitudes, skills)
- who to trust
- who NOT to trust
- conclusions

2. Plan your survival guide for people:

- title page (with your name on it as the author)

- overview and statement of purpose (e.g.: to help young people who want to travel /live in a new place, try something new like going to college, or....)

- list of what one needs to survive (things to bring, attitudes, skills)
- who to trust
- who NOT to trust
- conclusions

Creating the booklet:

1. Take 3 sheets of paper (computer paper, construction paper, etc.). Holding all three of them together, fold in half once - in order to make a booklet with 12 pages (front and back). Note: If you need more than one page for any of the topics above, then you will want to add an additional page or two.

2. Put your ideas for the survival guide for fish on the first 6 pages (up to the middle of the booklet). Use one page for each of the 6 topics above. Illustrate and decorate.

3. Flip your booklet over until you have a new cover page. Now write the survival guide for people, using the other 6 pages. Illustrate and decorate.

What you will be graded on:

- inclusion of each of the six topics/pages
- creativity

inclusion of **specific information from the story

- understanding the author's meaning in your parallel survival guide for people
