David Gramling is Assistant Professor in the Department of German Studies at the University of Arizona, and Co-Investigator on the Arts and Humanities Research Council of the United Kingdom (AHRC) Large Grant “Researching Multilingually at the Borders of Language, the Body, Law, and the State.” His book *The Invention of Monolingualism* will be published in October 2016 with Bloomsbury. He is currently a National Endowment for the Arts Translation Fellow, for a co-translation (with Aron Aji) of Murathan Mungan’s poetry collection *The Heart’s East*.
