Instructions for Teachers

Purpose:

It is extremely important that students are able to experience world cultures as a means of learning about them. The focus of this "Virtual Field Trip" is to help students gain a deeper understanding of the ways of life of Turkish people through a mock visit to the country.

This curriculum may be used with all ages.

Using these materials:

There are many ways that these materials may be used with your classes. You may present the Virtual Field Trip as a power point to your class, or have individual students view the slide show on their own. The questions that accompany the slide show do so chronologically, so students should answer the questions as they go through the different slides in order.

These documents are not copyrighted and you are encouraged to copy and distribute them. The slide show may be saved on different computers by following these steps:

1. Click on "My Computer" from the desktop.
2. Click on the CD icon.
3. You should see a list of materials that are saved on the CD. From this list click *once* on "Virtual Field Trip to Turkey."
4. Open the "File" menu and scroll down to "Send To." A separate menu should appear on the right.
5. Choose "My Documents" from this menu.
6. Access this file by opening "My Documents" and choosing "Virtual Field Trip to Turkey."
7. You may repeat this process with the additional files from the disk.

By copying the files onto your own or other teachers' computers, you may access the files without the CD. However, you may also burn a copy of the CD to share with colleagues.



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
